

Instructions for Parade Participates 2008 Official Rules

1. Reporting and Parade Information Center: The person in charge of each entry shall report to the check in center from 7:00-8:45 AM. If you check in anytime after 8:45 you may forfeit being judged. Late entries will only be taken until 9:30 AM

2. Judging Locations:

a. Floats: Please assemble your float in the west LDS parking lot and be ready to be judged by 8:30. Line up will follow at 9:30. Awards will be handed out at the beginning of the parade.

b. Commercial: Please assemble and park your entry in the east parking lot of the LDS parking lot. Be setup and ready to be judged by 9:00. Line up will begin at 9:30. Awards will be handed out at the beginning of the parade.

c. Horse Units: There are several locations for unloading and loading. All large groups (posses) will unload in the parking lot just past 14th and Main in the parking lot of Rodney's/China Buffet then proceed to the lot at 12th and Main. All royalty will unload in the empty lot adjacent to the Kix Stand at 13th and Main and all others will unload in the lot next to the red brick building at 12th and Main. Judging begins at 8:30 AM sharp. Please be on time as you will not be judged if not in position when the judges pass by. Starting point of the parade is at 13th and Main so you will need to line up in the alley way in numerical order at 9:30 AM. You must provide a pooper scooper.

d. Cars: Please set up and be ready to be judged along Pine Street closest to the tennis courts. Judging will begin at 9:00 AM.

e. Bands/Drill/Cheer: You will need to set up along 13th, facing North (between the bowling alley and El Caporal). Be ready to go by 9:30

F. Political: Please set up in the East parking lot of the Othello Bowl. Be ready to go by 9:30.

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g. All commercial trucks will be lined up along Main Street, facing west, numerically. (Please try to stay next to the left hand side along the street and be careful not to walk on the landscaping.

2. Parade Requirements: We would appreciate it if all entries would keep a minimum of 30 feet between each unit during the parade. There will be a parade official at the corner of 13th and Main to direct you.

3. Announcer: In front of the City Hall will be an announcer so when you get to that point you might consider slowing down and pausing while the announcer reads your parade information before moving on. We are a small parade so time is not essential for us. A few minutes will not hurt to get behind. We just don't want large gaps as the crowds will get agitated.

4. Distribution of Candy: In order to reduce risk factors, distribution of candy and material should be done as follows:

- a. Candy and materials can be handed out to the crowd
- b. If candy is thrown to the parade crowd, it should be thrown out as far as possible to lessen the risk of children running in the streets
